cently it was declared “deficiency-free”, after an extensive review by the State of Colorado. Additionally, in 2008 it was selected to receive the Precision Plumbing Community Award.

Cinnamon Park is an affordable option, Medicaid certified residence, with a long-established wellness program and a staff who have been there for many, many years. Situated in a quiet, residential neighborhood in Longmont, it is designed for seniors who need a supportive setting that maintains their independence and choices in life. Traditional architecture, natural light and comfortable furnishings give Cinnamon Park the look and feel of a large, single-family residence. Beautifully landscaped grounds draw residents outdoors to relax, take a walk or visit with friends and family. With the help of generous donors and in celebration of its anniversary, Cinnamon Park was able to purchase a bus for outings in and around the com-



munity and a remodeling project is also right around the corner.

Over 80% of SHO’s assisted living residents receive Colorado Medicaid benefits. Because of state budget cuts, this year Medicaid benefits have been reduced for the first time ever. So, community support is especially important this year.

Come and celebrate at Cinnamon Park! Senior Housing Options is a nonprofit charitable organization whose mission is “to provide and promote quality, affordable housing and services in a caring environment for older adults in Colorado.” It owns and manages 14 assisted-living and subsidized housing residences for 500 low and moderate income elderly and persons with disabilities.
