Western banks, give economic aid to the new Ukraine government, and isolate Russia diplomatically, denying their ability to play a role in international leadership. Whether these measures outweigh Putin's need to control the Ukraine is yet to be seen. NATO ministers Sunday proposed international monitors to ensure ethnic rights to allow all sides to cool off.

The new Ukraine government overplayed its hand. It overturned a law giving official recognition to Russian as a second language, a signal they were not going to respect the

rights of the large number of Russian speakers. The Russian ethnics felt that their rights and security were endangered, giving the Russian military a reason to sneak into the Crimea. This should be a lesson for future 'spring' movements anywhere else in the world where there are ethnic or religious divisions, such as Bosnia. Protection of minority and ethnic rights must be an enforceable and stated goal of any group aspiring to change a regime by force or by the ballot, or they lay the groundwork for a shaky future and meddling by outside forces.
