The Park Hill Adult Day Program opened its doors on February 10, 2025. The Adult Day Program serves people impacted by Dementia and will provide both social connection and engagement, as well as memory enrichment and new experiences for participants. Our program can also provide caregivers with the break from caregiving that they need during the day, and help them continue to care for their loved ones at home by freeing up time, energy and resources. The cost of the program is intentionally priced at an accessible cost point to serve a critical need in the community. We offer programming and enrichment that not only keeps participants safe, but helps them maintain and build new neuropathways, which can help slow dementia and improve the experience of aging. A day program like ours can help keep people out of institutional care communities and help them age in place. 
