You may be eligible for Aid & Attendance Benefits that can help pay for home care, family caregivers, and assisted living services.

Pension is for Wartime Veterans with low income who are permanently and totally disabled.

Widow's of Wartime Veterans need only be low income.

Aid & Attendance is an additional benefit for Veterans and Widows who need the help of someone to do their Activities of Daily Living such as bath-dress-manager medications or for psychiatric conditions or supervision if they can't be left alone.

There are two things considered of all Pension claims:

1. Does the veteran have Wartime Service-they must only serve during war time
2. Net worth must be under \$70,000. If they are living in their home is it not considered if they don't live in it but still own it is considered net worth.
